This privacy policy sets out how Avaada Ventures India uses, and disclosure of personal data and protects any information that you give Avaada Ventures when you use this website.

Privacy and Security – Our approach

Information Collection and Use

We are committed to ensuring that your information is secure. In order to prevent unauthorized access or disclosure, we have put in place suitable physical, electronic and managerial procedures to safeguard and secure the information we collect online. We expect our employees to know how to protect information and to challenge others who fail to do so.



Our strategy, Doing What's Right, raises awareness of security risks throughout the business and deepens our security culture.

Types of Data Collected

Personal Data

While using our Service, we may ask you to provide us with certain personally identifiable information that can be used to contact or identify you ("Personal Data"). Personally identifiable information may include, but is not limited to:

- Name and job title.
- Contact information including email address (First name; last name and Phone number)
- Address, State, Province, ZIP/Postal code, City
- Cookies and Usage Data
- demographic information such as preferences and interests.

Usage Data

We may also collect information how the Service is accessed and used ("Usage Data"). This Usage Data may include information such as your computer's Internet Protocol address (e.g. IP address), browser type, browser version, the pages of our Service that you visit, the time and date of your visit, the time spent on those pages, unique device identifiers and other diagnostic data.

Transfer of Data

Your information, including Personal Data, may be transferred to — and maintained on — computers located outside of your state, province, country or other governmental jurisdiction where the data protection laws may differ than those from your jurisdiction.

If you are located outside India and choose to provide information to us, please note that we transfer the data, including Personal Data, to India and process it there.

Your consent to this Privacy Policy followed by your submission of such information represents your agreement to that transfer. Avaada Ventures will take all steps reasonably necessary to ensure that your data is treated securely and in accordance with this Privacy Policy and no transfer of your Personal Data will take place to an organization or a country unless there are adequate controls in place including the security of your data and other personal information.

Password Security

Avaada Ventures firmly believes in protecting the information of the employees/investor's and customer. Generally, the default password will be generated by system administrator and once it is received by you, you are requested to change the same and have your own password. It is recommended that you choose your own passwords carefully such that no unauthorized access is made by a third party. It is also advised not to keep any written or other record of the password/s so that no third party could access the same.

We do not disclose any kind of non-public personal information about our Investors or former Investors to anyone, except when we believe it necessary for the conduct of our business, or where disclosure is required by law. Except in those specific, limited situations, without your consent, we will not make any disclosures of non-public personal information to other companies.

The security of your data is important to us, but remember that no method of transmission over the Internet, or method of electronic storage is 100% secure. While we strive to use commercially acceptable means to protect your Personal Data, we cannot guarantee its absolute security.

Children's Privacy
